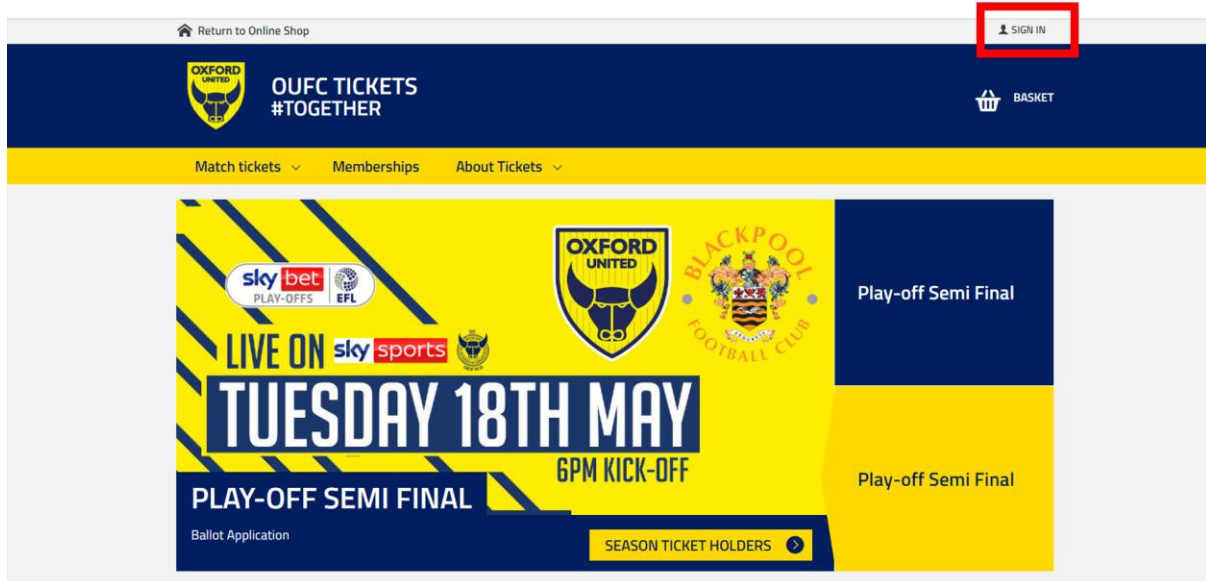


OUFC Ballot Application Process:

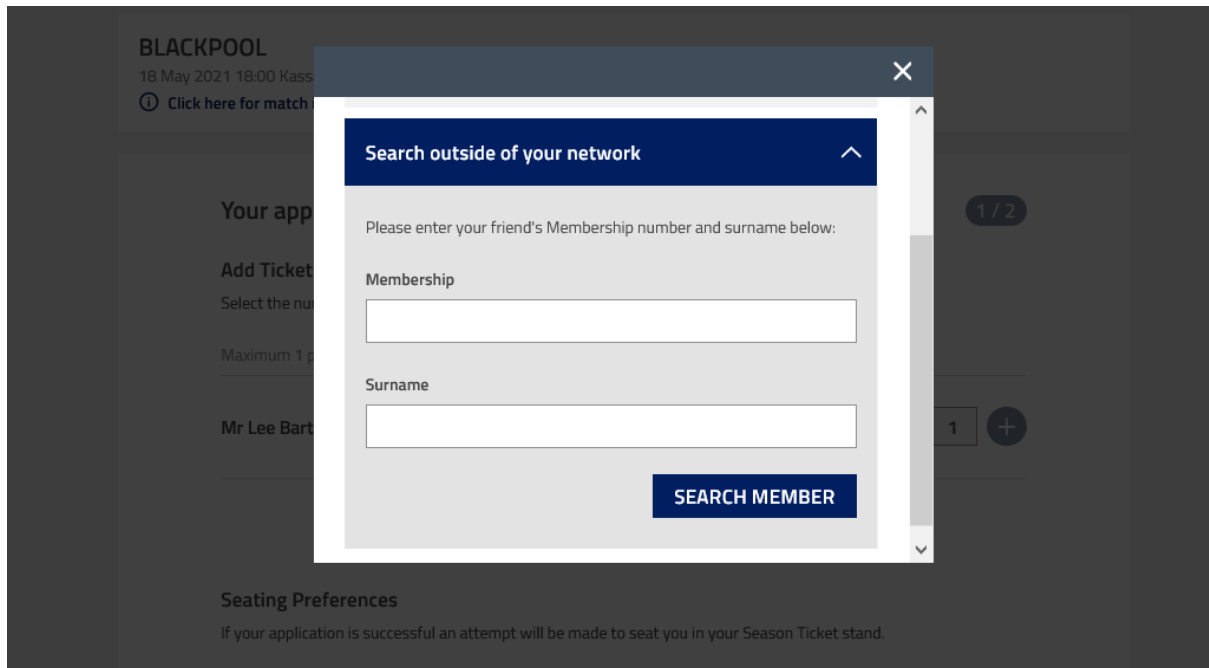
3. Click the 'Season Ticket Holders' button to visit the ballot application page

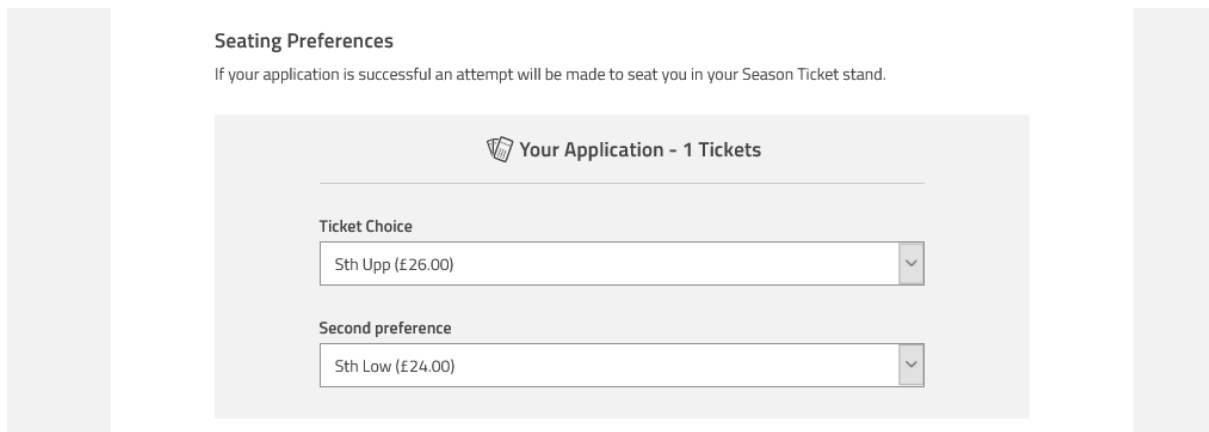
4. Click 'Add another member' to increase your group size up to a maximum of six. All ballot applications for group sizes of seven or more will be voided

9. The ballot will remain open until 9am on Friday 14th May, at which point the club will begin the process of randomly allocating seats to supporters. Season Ticket holders in the 1893 Club will be required to enter the ballot.

10. If you are successful in the ballot, you will receive a booking confirmation email that will detail the stand, row, and seat, along with a PDF of your match ticket(s). No physical match tickets will be made available on the day, and entry will be solely by digital ticket or tickets printed at home.
